Study Questions

- 1) Today's sermon had to do with the “time capsule” called worship. Read 2 Chronicles 20:1-24 to set the stage. Tell this story in your words in no more than 3 sentences.
- 2) What is unusual about the formation of the army of Israel as they marched out to meet their enemies?
- 3) What is the Hebrew word for “loving kindness” and what does it mean? Knowing this, does it have an impact on your heart of worship? Write about it.
- 4) How did this story impact Israel's future? In reading Rev 12:1-17 and Daniel 11:35-41 we see God delivering to Israel in the end times for their rescue, the land that actually was theirs to claim since Jehoshaphat's victory. Do you agree that Jesus had this in mind in Matthew 24:15-22?
- 5) What are we reminding God of, when we worship Him like Israel did under King Jehoshaphat? Do you believe that God stores up victory for us — to give to us when we'll need it most — whenever we worship Him that way?
