Study Questions

Ice breaker question: If anything were possible, what experience would you most like to have?

- 1) What does the idiom “end of my rope” mean in our current culture? Have you ever been there? Care to share such a time? What is the original British phrase — from the 1600’s, — that was the source of that idiom? Describe the meaning of the original word-picture that was intended to be ‘painted’ by that old British phrase.
- 2) How does the phrase “end of my rope” help us better understand what every believer needs?
- 3) Who is the one who brings desperation at “the end of your rope”? Read Matt. 4:1-4. What did Jesus mean by his answer to Satan? When will we receive the “every word” that Jesus was talking about?
- 4) Read Revelation 3:20. Jesus is calling His whole Church to seek His face — especially the ‘last Church’ before the last 7 years of human history. If we are that Church, then what do we most need from Him?
- 5) Does anyone have a word from God-to-you, that He has given you at some point, that you’d like to share tonight? Even today, we may feel that we are at the end of our rope. What must we do — whether we feel that way or not — to hear from Him in the coming week or weeks?
