## “Where’s God In All This?”



### Study Questions

Ice breaker question: What person from history would you like to have a conversation with (not Jesus)?

- 1) David Wilkerson’s prophecy in 1986 said, “I see a plague coming on the world, and the bars, churches, and government will shut down. The plague will hit NYC and shake it like it has never been shaken. The plague is going to force prayerless believers into radical prayer and into their Bibles, and repentance will be the cry from the man of God in the pulpit. And out of it will come a third Great Awakening that will sweep America and the world.” What did he mean by a third Great Awakening?
- 2) A ‘Great Awakening’ is a term coined by non-religious historians to describe a national movement that is a ‘religious earthquake’ resulting in widespread changes. In 1980 — exactly 40 years ago this Wednesday 4/29 — what happened in Washington DC that came out of a ‘call to prayer’ for a third Great Awakening?
- 3) Christian leaders in 1980 based their Washington DC gathering — attended by 200,000 people — on 2 Chronicles 7:14. What is the key phrase in that verse? Read Exodus 33:7-11. What did this key phrase mean to Moses? To Joshua? Now read Joshua 1:1-2.
- 4) What “wicked ways” did we nationally need to repent from in 1980? In 2020? Now read Rev. 3:14-20. Explain the ancient “fellowship meal”, and how it is the equivalent of “seeking His face”.
- 5) Read 2 Chron 7:12-14, which gives us God’s words leading up to 2 Chron 7:14. Look at the word “pestilence”. What is that?
- 6) “Moses is dead”, and the pestilence is here. What does God desire from those of us who will respond? Who among us are eligible to be the ‘Joshuas’ of our day?
